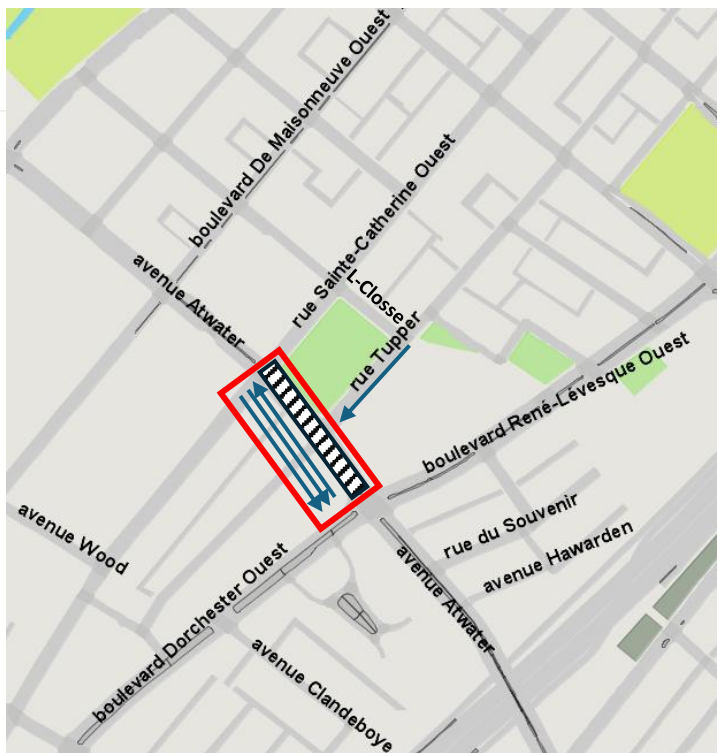

Reconstruction work on a water main

On Avenue Atwater between Boulevard René-Lévesque Ouest and Rue Sainte-Catherine Ouest



Vehicular traffic

Avenue Atwater:

- Full closure of east side lanes between Boulevard René-Lévesque Ouest and Rue Sainte-Catherine Ouest.
- Contraflow traffic on the west side, with one lane northbound and two lanes southbound.
- Police presence to help ensure the flow of traffic.

Rue Tupper:

- Eastbound closure between Avenue Atwater and Rue Lambert-Closse; one lane maintained westbound.
- Thank you for complying with the onsite signage.

-  : Worksite
-  : Closure northbound
-  : Three traffic lanes or one traffic lane

IMPORTANT

Two other work phases will be required during the summer on Avenue Atwater between:

- Rue Saint-Jacques and Rue Notre-Dame Ouest
- Rue Saint-Antoine and Boulevard René-Lévesque Ouest

A detailed construction notice will be sent out for each of these phases.

The work schedule is aimed at optimizing worksite management as well as minimizing and reducing the duration of obstructions.

The construction work may be postponed or extended due to weather conditions and other circumstances.

Parking and mobility



- **Parking:** Restrictions in effect within worksite boundaries and on certain cross streets to allow for two-way configuration.
- **Active transportation:** Detours and alternate configurations for pedestrians and cyclists.
- **Public transportation:** Services maintained, but some stops and schedules may change. The Atwater metro station will remain accessible at all times.

Worksite information



- **Access to buildings:**
 - Access on foot to residences, businesses and institutions is maintained at all times.
 - Delivery and drop-off zones may be configured temporarily, as needed.
 - A liaison agent will coordinate with businesses and institutions to minimize the impact on their operations.



- **Signalling crews:** Onsite for the duration of construction work for road safety.
- **Work schedule:** Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.



- **Garbage, recycling and composting within the worksite perimeter:** On collection days, place your bins in their usual location, ensuring that your address is written visibly on them. Bins that are not accessible to collection crews will be relocated by the contractor.
- If you use mobility assistance devices such as strollers, crutches, mobility scooters, etc. or if you are planning to move or carry out work on your property, or for any other situation that the worksite manager should know about, please contact 514-872-3777.
